

Art Teacher

Foundational Criteria: BFA/BVA/BA Fine Arts or a recognised qualification in Fine Arts/Visual Arts, along with a relevant Art Education certificate/diploma and teacher-training qualification.

Work Experience: Minimum 5 years of school experience.

Key Responsibilities

1. **Minimum 5 years of school teaching experience**, with a recognised qualification of BFA/BVA/BA in **Fine Arts/Visual Arts**.
2. Plan and deliver engaging, age-appropriate art lessons aligned with the school curriculum and learning objectives.
3. Teach diverse techniques across drawing, painting, craft and visual arts.
4. Nurture creativity, imagination, self-expression and confidence through art.
5. Develop age-appropriate art projects, activities and learning resources.
6. Guide individual and group art projects while supporting students' artistic development.
7. Organise and support student participation in art exhibitions, competitions and school activities.
8. Assess students' artwork and provide constructive feedback to encourage artistic growth.
