

Counsellor – Senior School

The role involves providing age-appropriate counselling and wellbeing support to senior school students. The Counsellor will support students in navigating academic, emotional, social and personal concerns while working closely with parents, teachers and school leadership when required.

Foundational Criteria: Master's degree in School Counselling Psychology, Psychology, Counselling Psychology or a relevant discipline.

Work Experience: Minimum 3 years of relevant experience.

Key Responsibilities

1. **Minimum 3 years of relevant counselling experience**, preferably in a school setting, with experience working with adolescents and senior school students.
2. Conduct one-on-one counselling sessions on university options, academic programmes and career pathways.
3. Provide structured guidance on standardised tests, including **SAT, ACT and APs**, and related academic requirements.
4. Guide students in identifying relevant scholarship and financial aid opportunities.
5. Advise students on international university applications, including documentation.
6. Conduct age-appropriate sessions on student wellbeing, life skills and awareness.
7. Foster a safe, supportive and inclusive environment that promotes student wellbeing.
