

Occupational Therapist

The role involves supporting students in developing the physical, sensory, motor, and functional skills required for their participation and independence in the school environment. The Occupational Therapist will help students to support individual developmental needs.

Foundational Criteria: Bachelor of Occupational Therapy (BOT) or a 3-year Diploma in Occupational Therapy from a recognised institution.

Work Experience: Minimum 3 years of relevant experience.

Key Responsibilities

1. **Minimum 3 years of relevant education-sector experience**, completion of the required **6-month clinical internship**, and a valid **DCPTOT professional registration/licence** to practise as an Occupational Therapist.
2. Assess students' motor, sensory, developmental and functional needs.
3. Plan and deliver individualised, evidence-based occupational therapy sessions.
4. Collaborate with teachers to recommend classroom strategies that support students' participation and daily functioning.
5. Design and deliver workshops and webinars from ideation to execution; **proficiency in PPT and Excel is essential**.
6. Monitor student progress and maintain accurate therapy records and documentation.
7. Maintain strict professional confidentiality and ensure the appropriate handling of student and therapy records.
